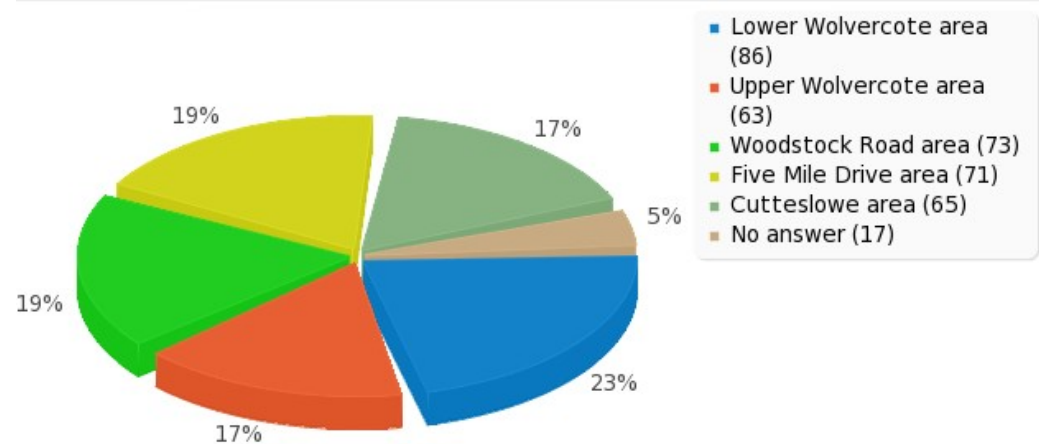

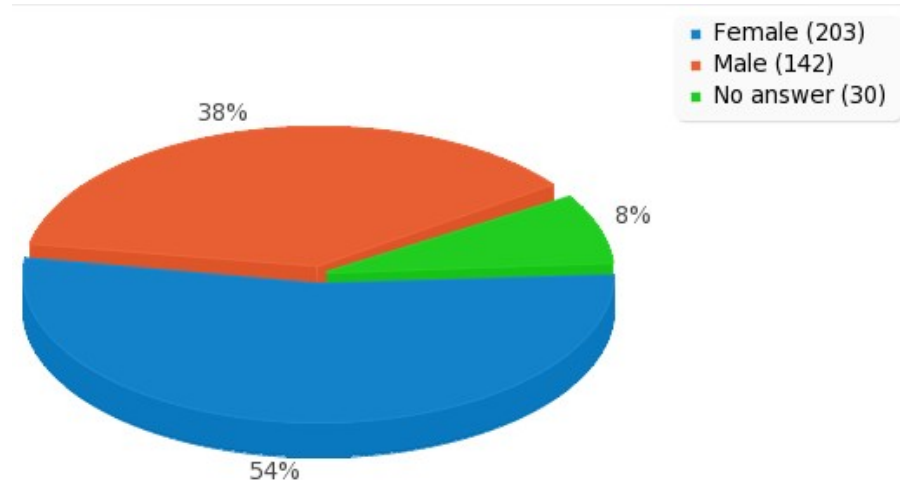

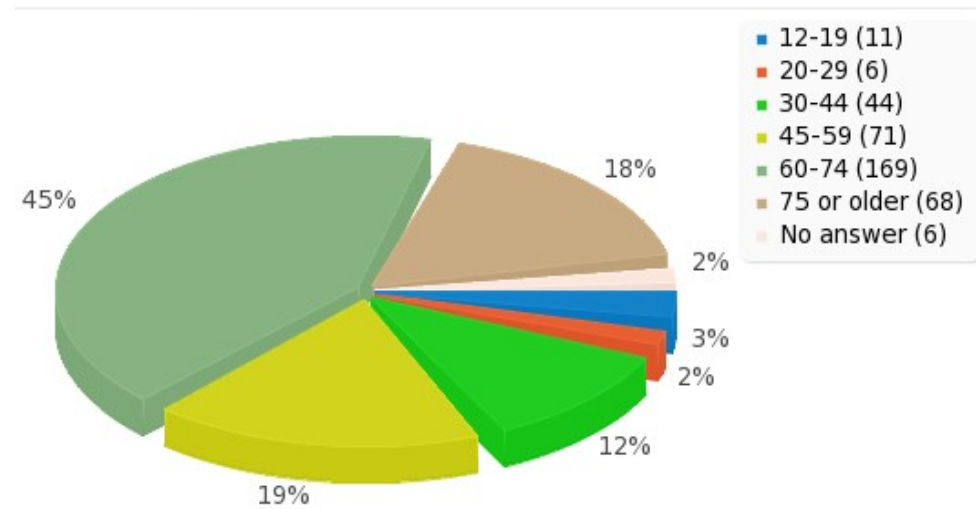

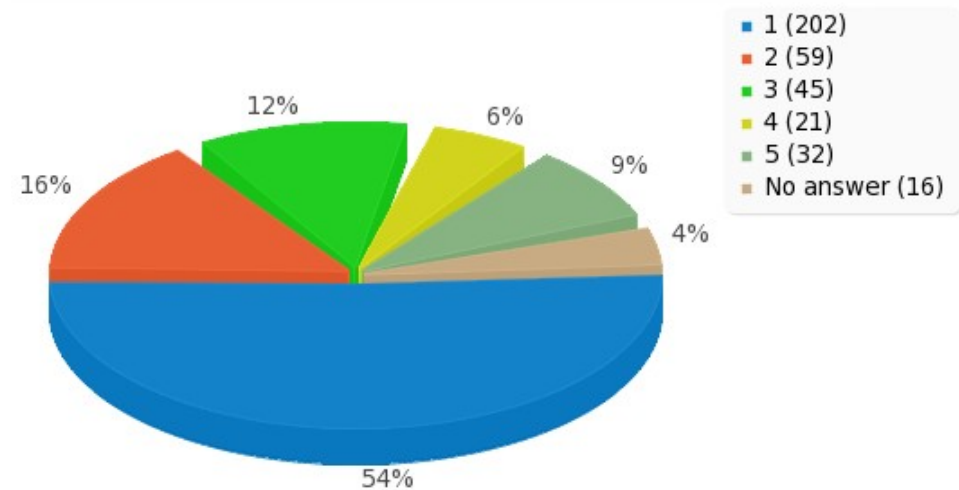

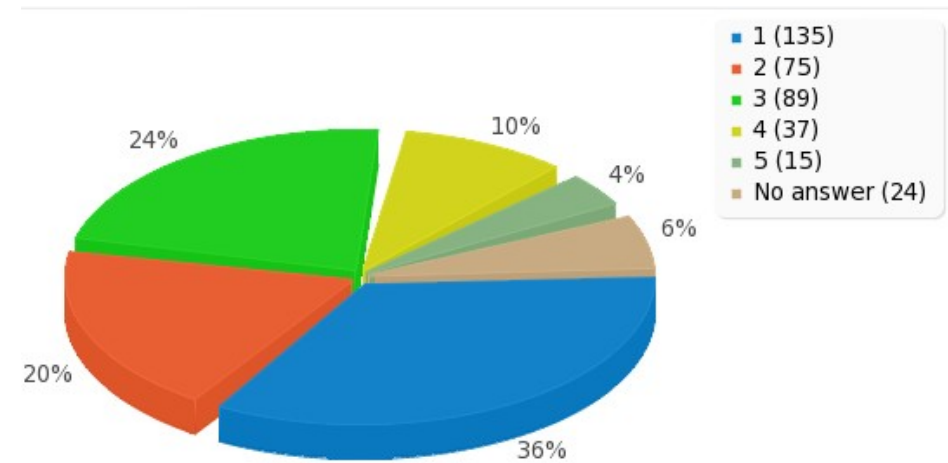

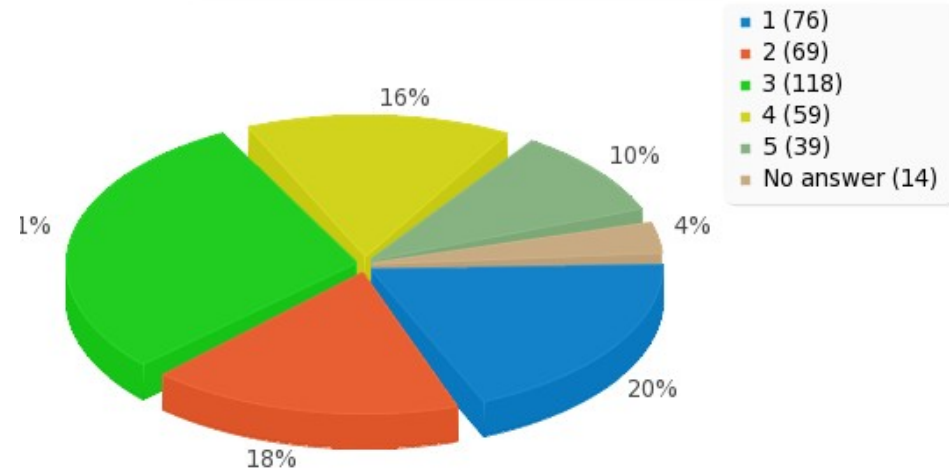

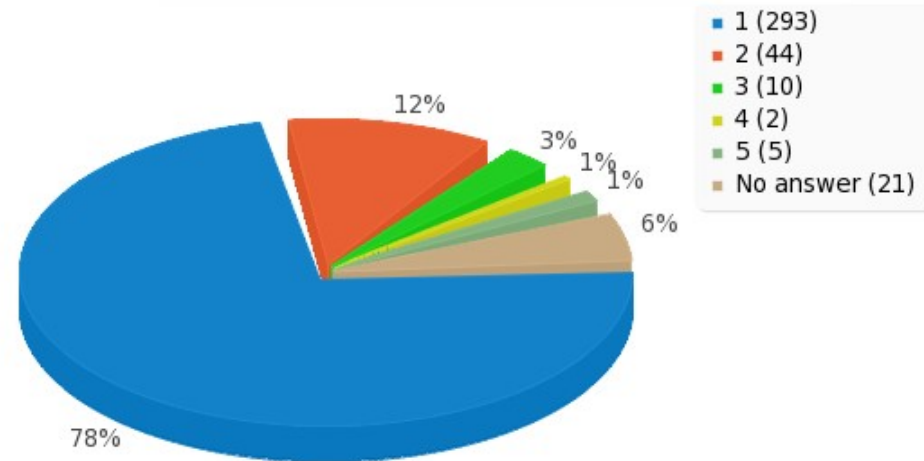

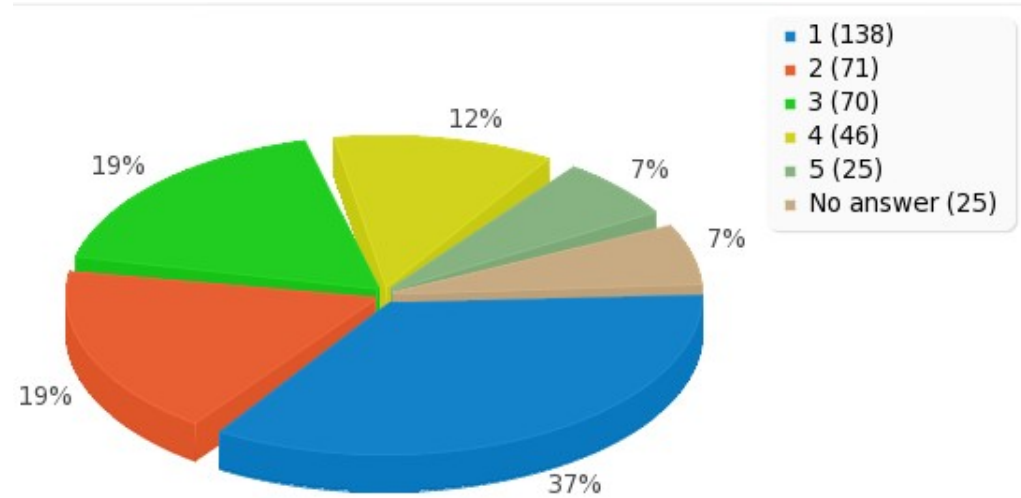

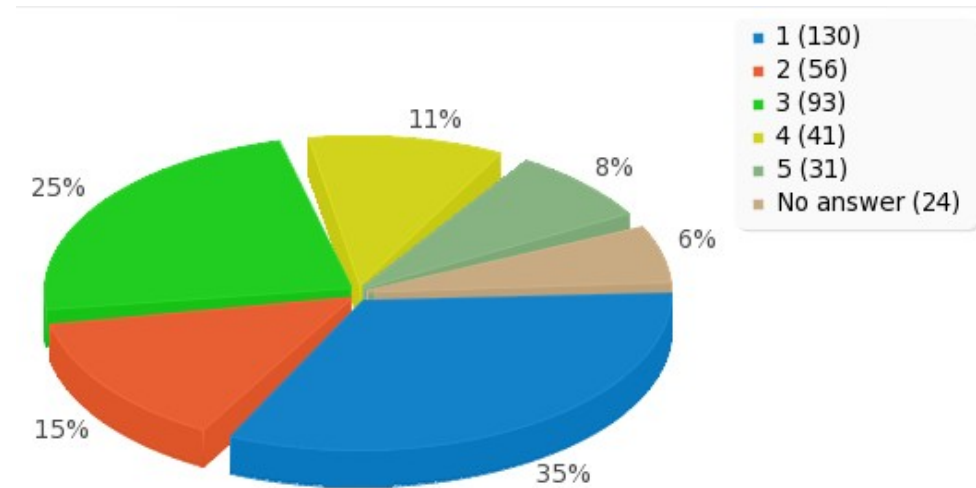

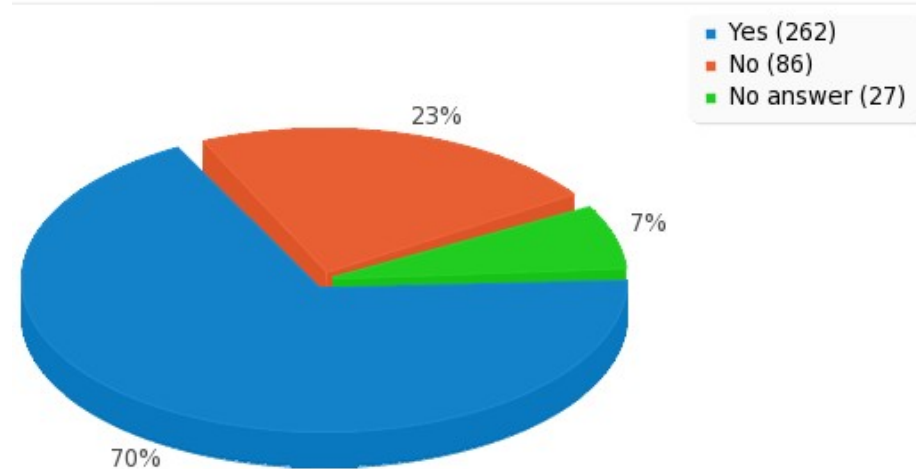

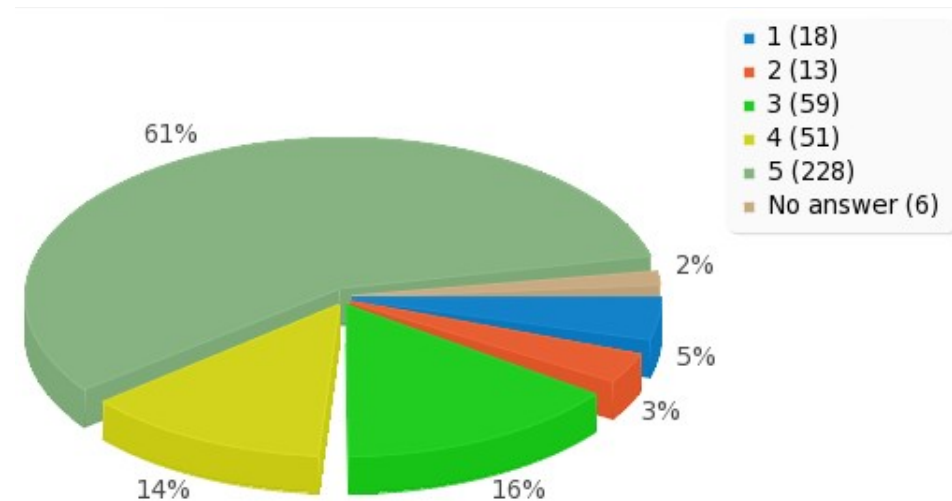

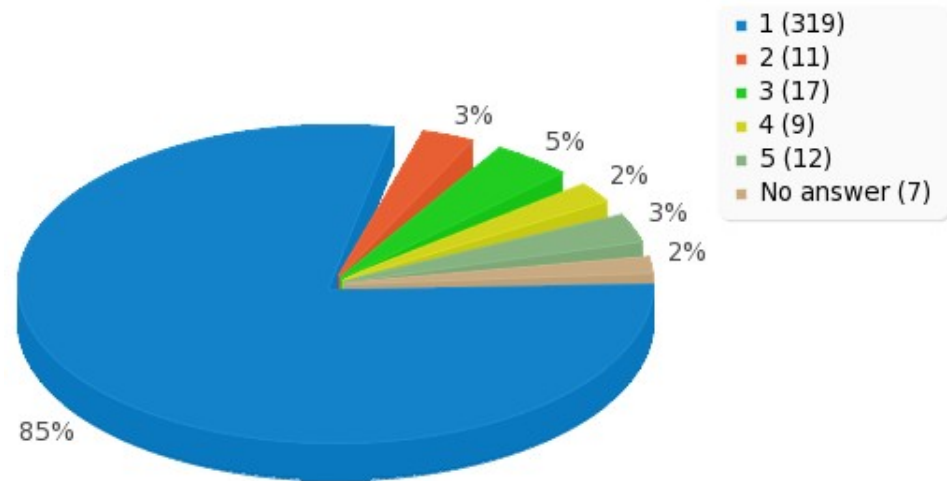

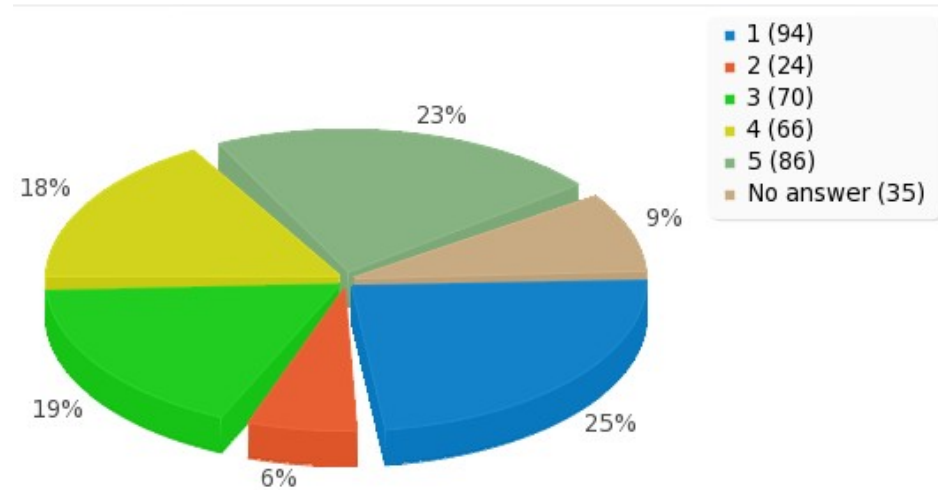

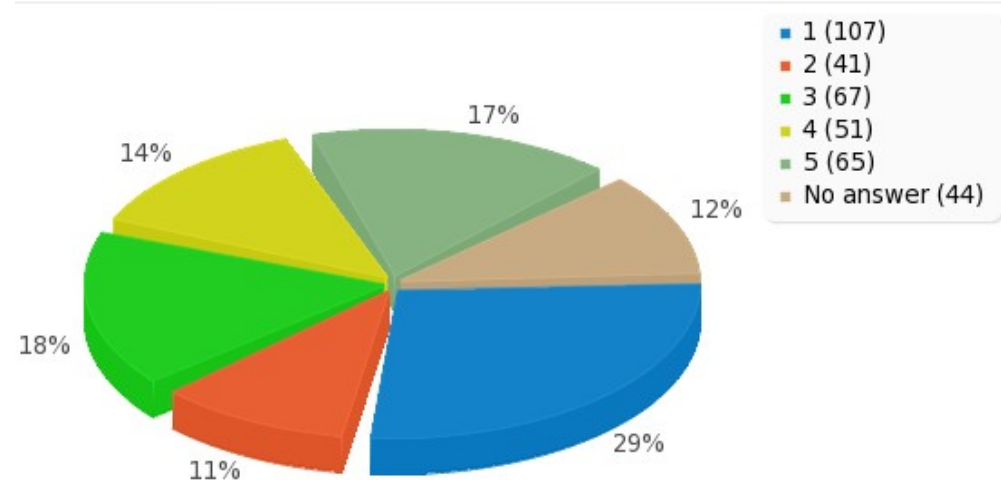

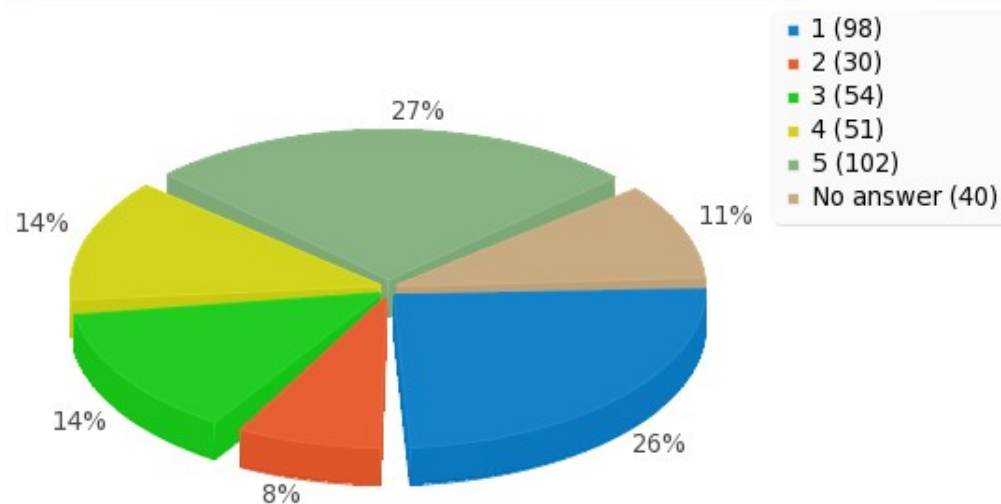

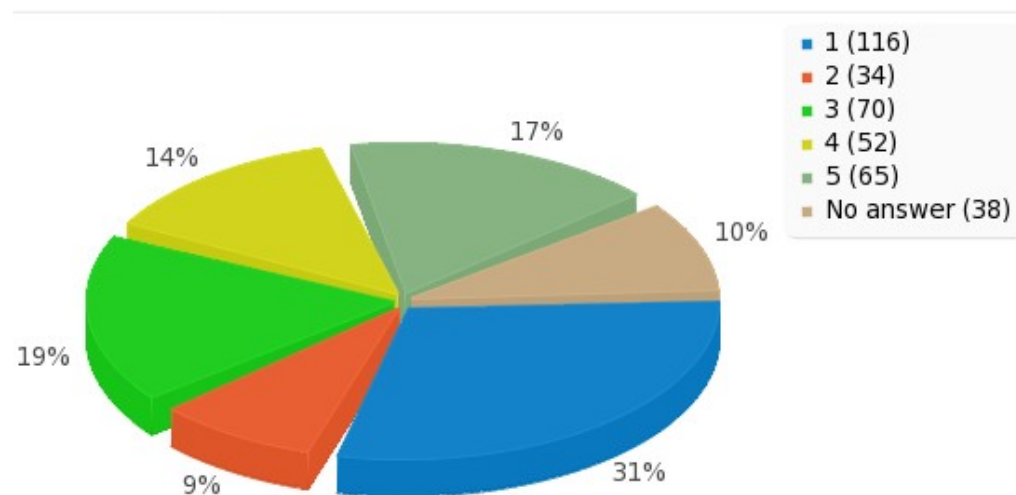

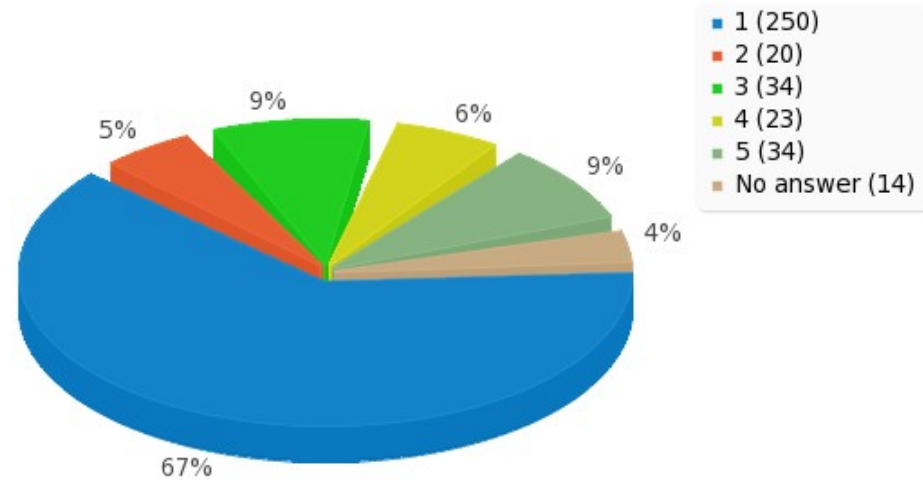

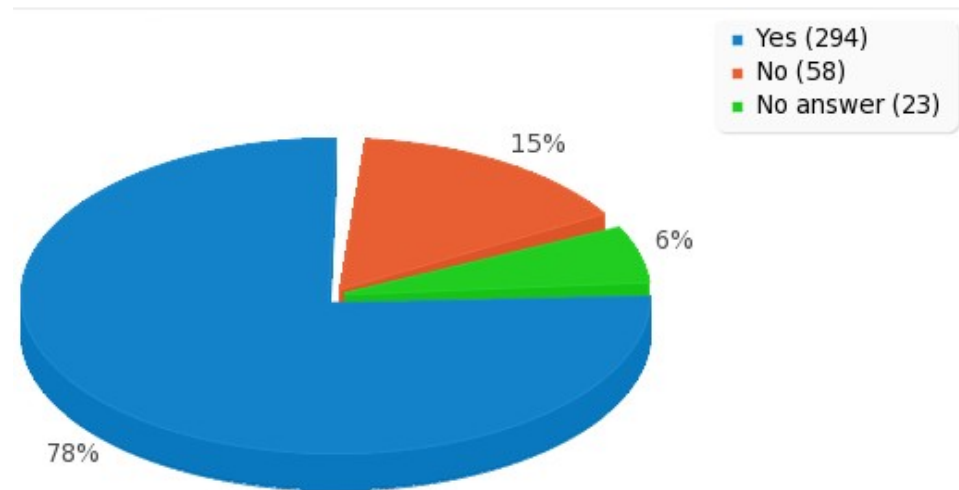

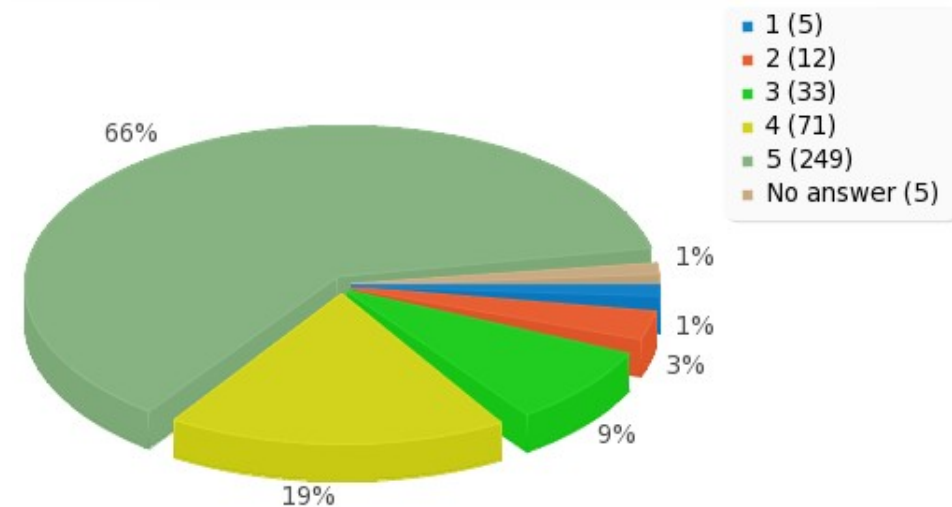

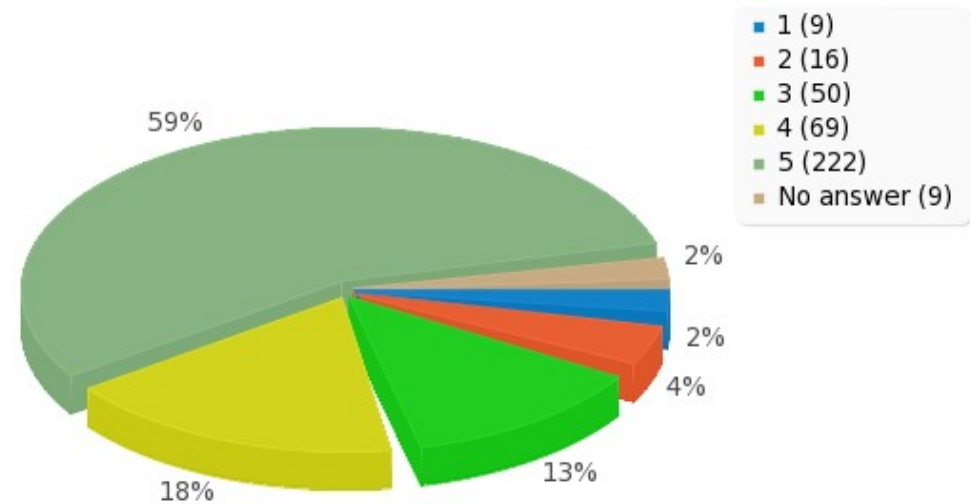

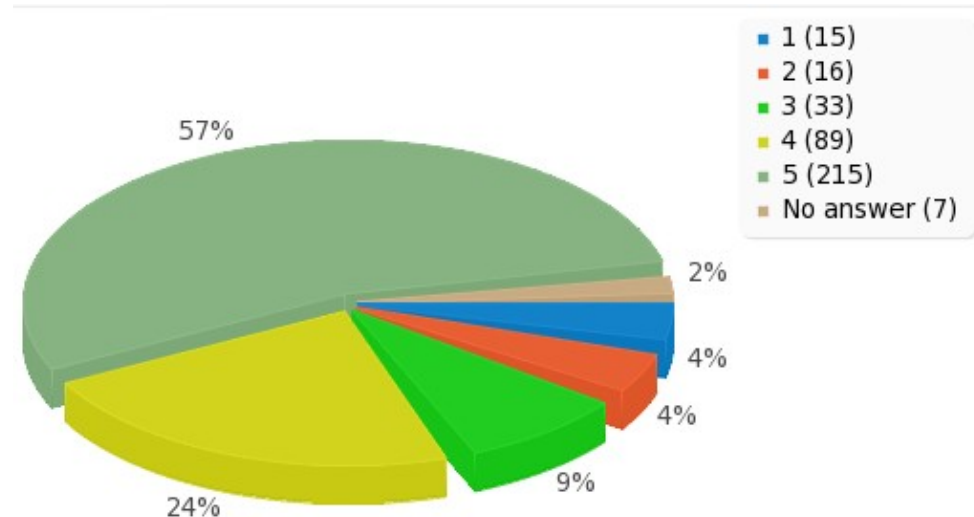

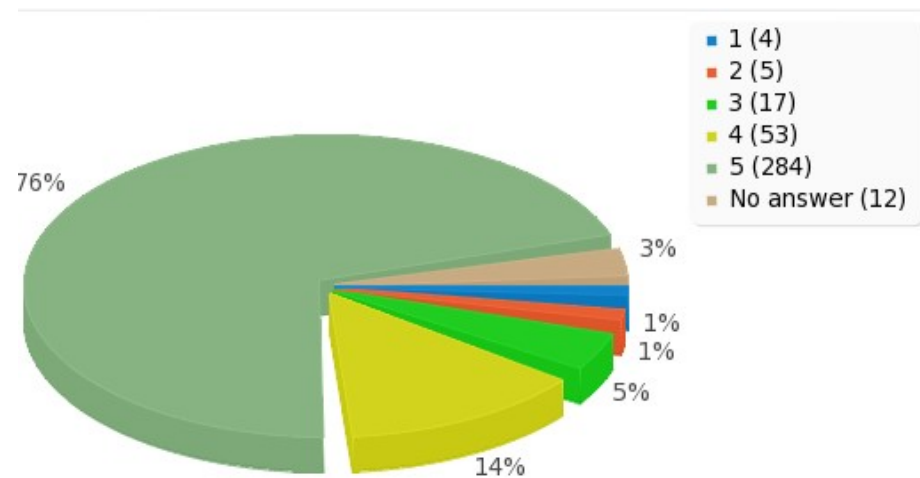

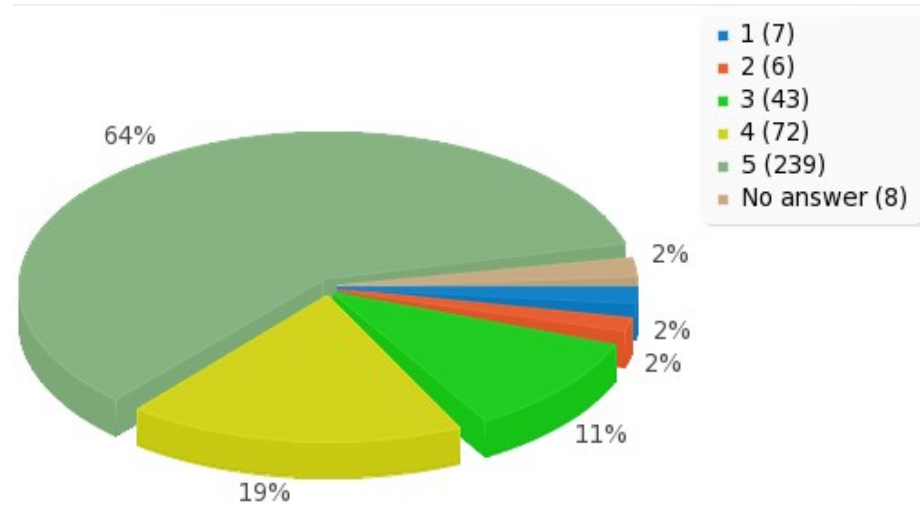

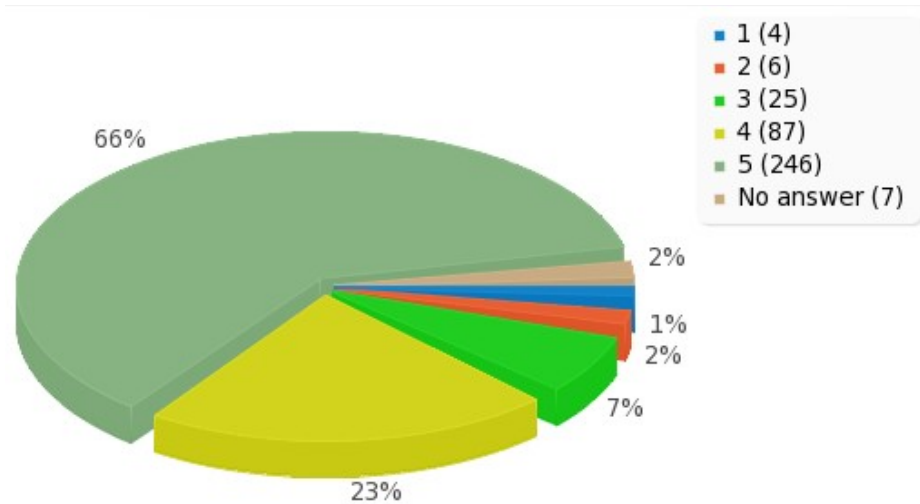

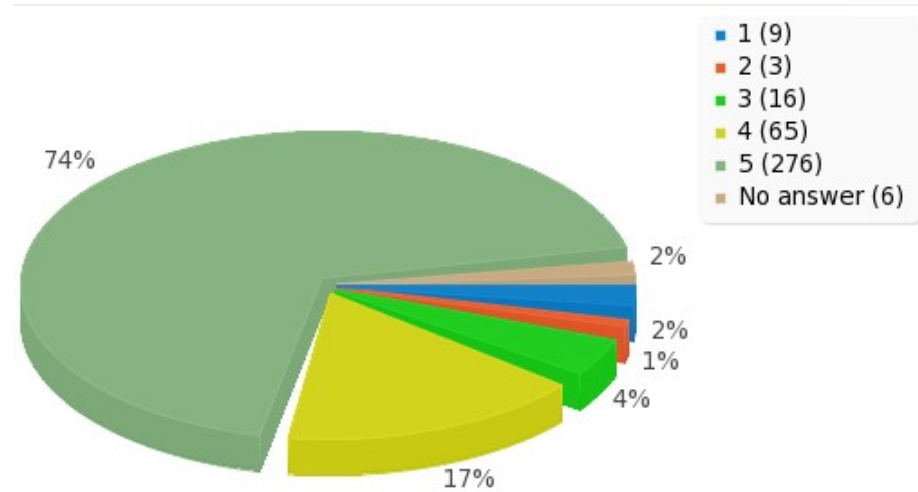

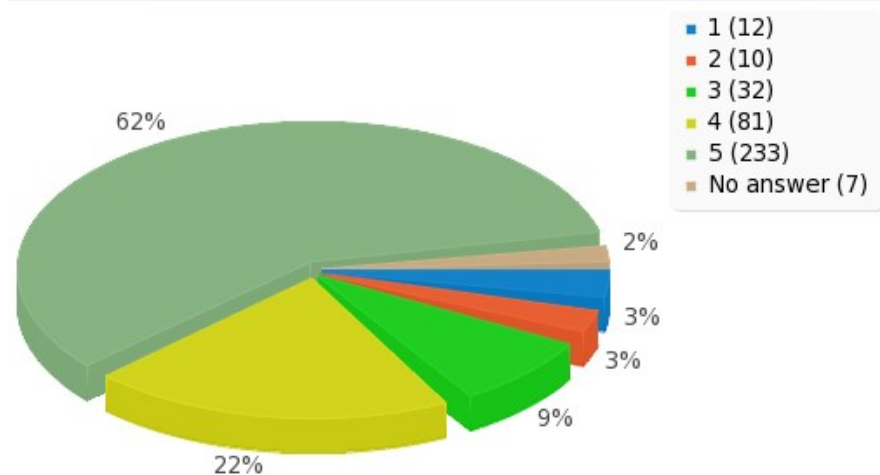

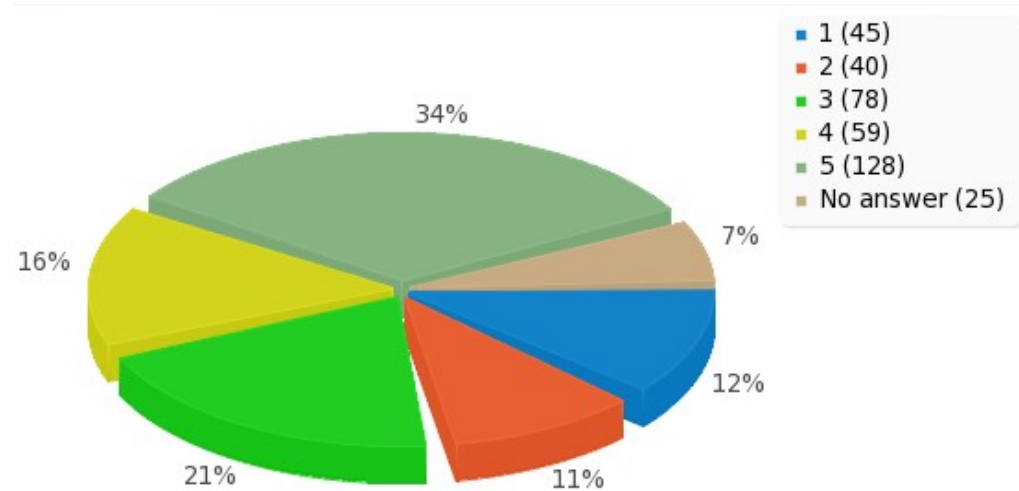

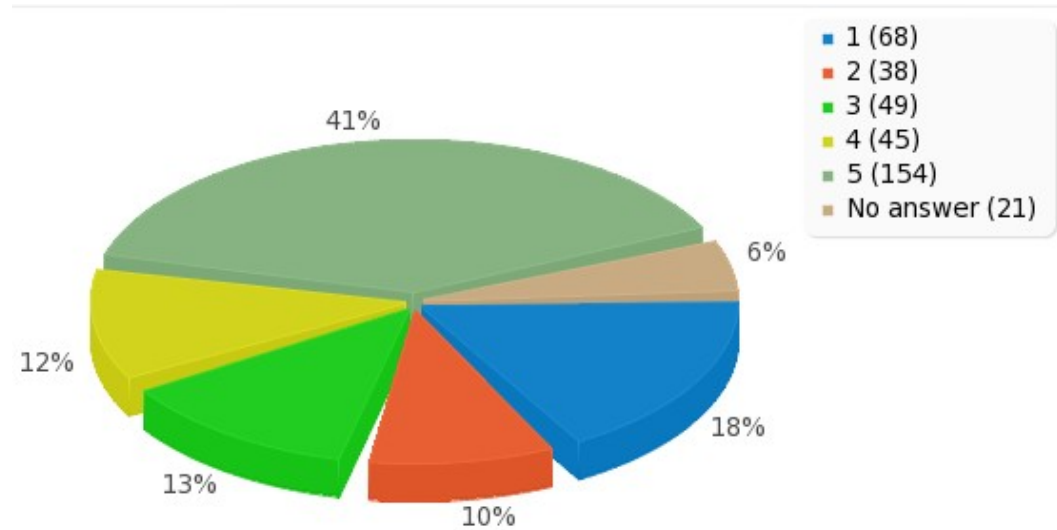


Illustration 28:

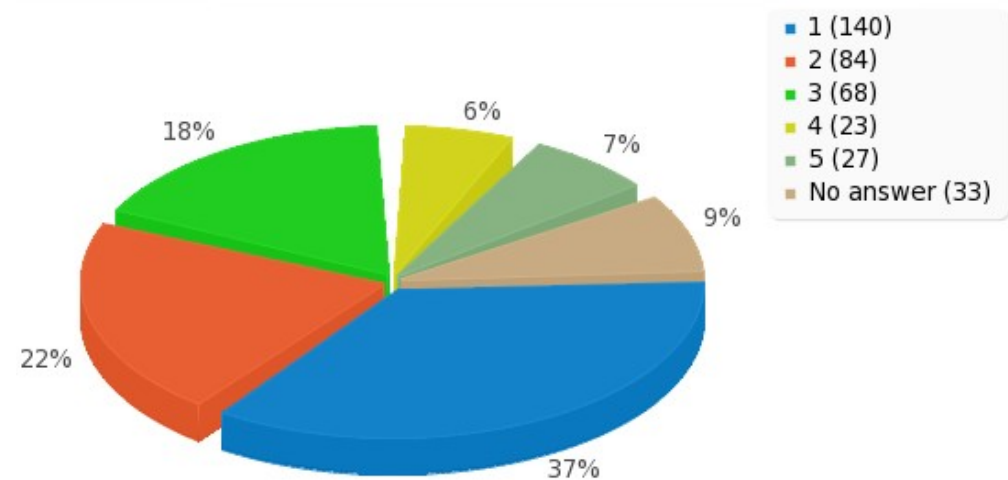


Illustration 29:

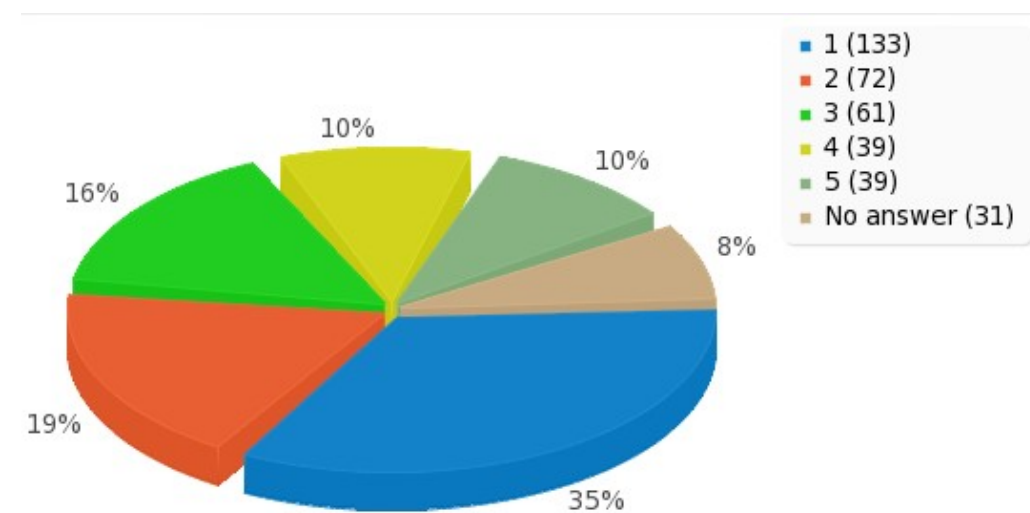

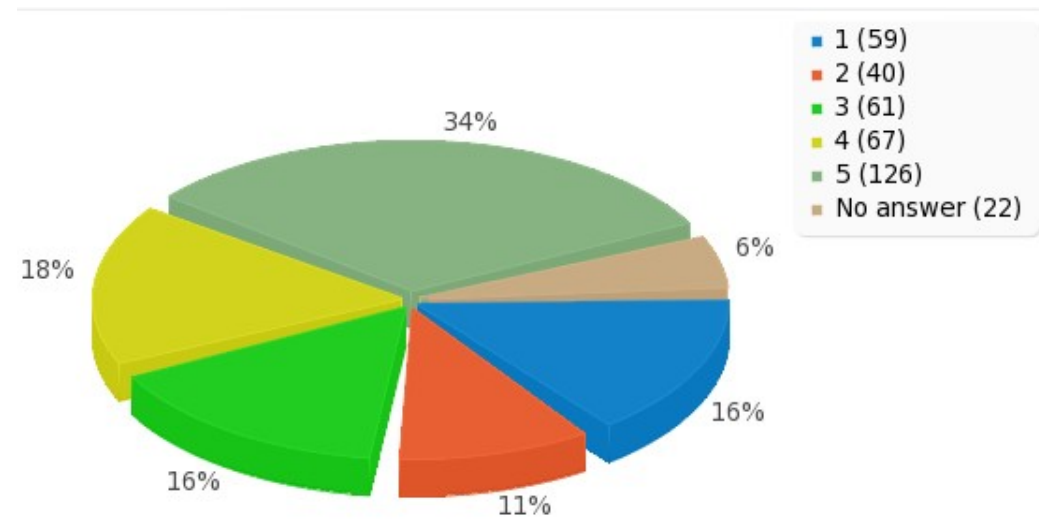
